

I labored not only over this pattern, but over stitching it up for my own children. What a beautiful way to get to know the heros of our faith! I hope you enjoy this project and that it serves your family well.

A few words about this pattern.

- This pattern is big. The PDF of this pattern is 9 pages long. In order to use it you will need to print it and assemble it. It will be three pages across and three pages down. Note the greyed out boxes along the edges. These boxes are the overlap boxes and should be covered by another sheet. They will hopefully help you in assembly.
- 2. You will need a big piece of aida cloth to complete this project. See measurements below.
- 3. I recommend stitching all cross stitches with 2 thread for 18 ct. cloth, and 3 threads for 14 or 11 ct.
- 4. To ensure that you do not run out of cloth, make sure to start stitching in the very center of the pattern and cloth.
- 5. Finally, I have altered a few of the colors needed for this pattern from the way I originally created the patterns. I did this so that you might not need so many colors. However, feel free to change the colors further if you desire. While stitching my own sampler I changed many colors and worked from a large box of thread I already had.
