6. Move to the beads on the circle. Say ten Hail Marys, one for each bead in that section, while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Move to the space following the last Hail Mary and say the Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer.
8. Move to the single bead, announce the Mystery, read the Scripture and say the Our Father, followed by ten Hail Marys. Repeat the same process for the remaining decades of the Rosary.
9. Following the 5th Mystery, say the Hail Holy Queen and Concluding Prayers.
10. Make the Sign of the Cross.


Concluding Prayer

How to Pray the Rosary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the Apostles' Creed while holding the crucifix.
2. Move to the first bead on the string extending from the circle. Say an Our Father for the intentions of the Holy Father.
3. Move to the three beads on the string extending from the circle. Say 3 Hail Marys asking for an increase in... Faith, Hope, and Love.
4. Move to the space following the three beads and say the Glory Be and the Fatima Prayer.
5. Move to the next bead. Announce the First Mystery. Read the Scripture passage corresponding with that mystery and quietly contemplate (optional). Then say Our Father.




The Proclamation of the Kingdom





The Scourging at the Pillar

The 1st Glorious Mystery


The Resurrection
